France. Premium Vins de Pays selected and blended with scrupulous regard to quality and freshness.

Marktree: Cabernet/Merlot £15.80

South East Australia. A smooth and fruity well-balanced red.

Garganega Pinot Grigio £15.80

Veneto, Italy. Easy drinking, fresh Garganega/PG blend. Ripe citrus fruit.

Montevista Sauvignon Blanc £16.20

Chile. Pure, lively fruit, mineral notes and a zingy finish.

Montevista Chardonnay £16.20

Chile. Delicious unoaked Chardonnay – vibrant and aromatic.

Ancora Chiaretto Rosato £15.80

Piedmont, Italy. Light and refreshing with ripe strawberry fruit character.

Foxcover White Zinfandel £16.20

California. A soft, fairly sweet pink with plenty of soft red fruit flavours.

Cape Heights Shiraz £15.80

Western Cape, South Africa. Ripe and Juicy. Full of dark fruit flavours.

Rioja Alta, Spain. Modern style, juicy, inviting Rioja.

Lunetta Prosecco Spumante brut £20

Veneto, Italy. Softly sparkling and refined. Deliciously light and fragrant.

CHAMPAGNE

Champagne Gremillet brut selection £34

France. Fine mousse and fresh, floral aromas. Well-balanced with a fine citrus finish. Great value.

Champagne Veuve Cliquot Ponsardin, Yellow Label brut £51

France. Classic, distinctive Champagne – one of the best. Complex, subtle yeast and biscuit flavours. Creamy, lingering dry finish.

RED WINES

Borsao Garnacha 2015/16 £16.50

Campo de Borja, Spain. Lively, juicy fruit; subtle hints of spice. Great value.

Rioja, Vega del Rayo seleccionada 2013/14 £19

Rioja Alta, Spain. Smooth and sophisticated. Generous fruit and good length.

Tesoro de Los Andes Malbec/Bonarda 2015/16 £17.50

Argentina. Full-bodied, smooth, round and savoury. Great with a steak.

Sixty Clicks Shiraz/Mataro 2014/15 £19

Central Victoria, Australia. Punchy, delicious all-rounder.

Novas Carménère/Cabernet Sauvignon 2012/13 £22

Chile. Vibrant, powerful organic red. A classic blend.

Séguret Côtes du Rhône Villages “Les Côteaux Schisteux” 2012/13 £27.50

Southern Rhône, France. Beautifully constructed with seamless, elegant texture and fantastic length. Definitive Rhône red: subtle, fine and satisfying.

Barbaresco “Corsini”, Araldica 2012/13 £25.50

Piedmont, Italy. Vibrant aromas; rich fruit; warm spices and sweet tannins. Classic Italian red from the noble Nebbiolo grape. Just made for beef or lamb.

Peacock Ridge Merlot 2011/14 £23

Stellenbosch, South Africa. Dark, dense up front fruit balanced by fine, seductive tannins. Long, complex finish.

Cahors, Château Pinteraie 2011/12 £25.50

South West France. Top-notch Malbec-based red. Tangy red berry fruit flavours and a delicious long finish of ripe cherries.

Domaine des Tourelles, 2011/12 £23.50

Bekaar Valley, Lebanon. Warm and rich with a hint of Arabian spice. From a long-established (founded in 1868) and highly-acclaimed winery.

Moko Black Pinot Noir 2014 £23.50

New Zealand. Elegant, and pleasingly fresh, with lovely strawberry fruit.

WHITE WINES

Cape Heights Chenin Blanc 2014/15 £17

Paarl, South Africa. Fresh and aromatic. Easy and versatile.

Orvieto Classico Secco "Libra", Baroncini 2014/15 £17.50

Tuscany, Italy. Elegant minerality, fruity bouquet. Clean, dry but generous palate.

Picpoul de Pinet, Duc de Morny, Cave de l'Ormarine 2014/15 £19.50

Languedoc, France. Floral and enticing. Exuberantly fresh, concentrated fruit palate with an underlying dry minerality. Excellent long finish.

Tabalí Reserva Viognier 2013/15 £23

Chile. Beautifully aromatic, pure Viognier with mouthfilling, creamy texture. Off-dry and unoaked, soft and rounded. Real value.

Quintas de Melgaço, Torre de Menagem Vinho Verde 2014/15 £21.50

Minho, Portugal. Classic, proper Vinho Verde with an appealing touch of spritz. A fine apéritif; great with seafood or white meats

Moko Black Sauvignon Blanc 2014/15 £24

New Zealand. Definitive Marlborough Sauvignon. Full, layered palate with hints of gooseberry and tropical fruit; clean, with good weight and balance.

Turckheim Réserve Riesling 2013/15 £24.50

Alsace, France. Elegant, distinguished wine with superb fruit, great acidic balance and an attractive mineral complexity.

Clos Saint Pierre Mâcon-Charnay, Le Quartier des Girouettes 2014 £25

Burgundy, France. Bright, stylish wine from old-vine Chardonnay; judicious use of oak gives fine breadth and texture. Suitable for vegetarians and vegans.

APÉRITIFS/DESSERT WINES

Monbazillac, Domaine de Grangeneuve 2010/11 (50cl. bottle) £19

South West France. Luscious, ethereal and honeyed, with an elegant finish. Great with cheese, or enjoy it French style as an aperitif. Not sticky sweet.

Late Harvest Gorka Izagirre Arima 2013/14 (50cl. Bottle) £27

Bizkaiko Txakolina, Spain. Gorgeous Basque sweet wine (sweet but not at all cloying) produced only in exceptional vintages.

FINE WINES – RED

Balgownie Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 £47

Victoria, Australia. Dark, sumptuous Cabernet from a famous, old estate. Juicy blackcurrant/chocolate/spice. Power tempered by finesse.

St Emilion Grand Cru, Clos de la Cure 2007 £48

Bordeaux, France. Complex claret of superb structure. Good fruit, solid, tight tannins and a long, satisfying finish.

Valenciso Rioja Reserva, Compañia Bodeguera de Valenciso 2004/06 £44

Rioja Alta, Spain. Pure Tempranillo: rich, elegant and beautifully understated. Combines the best of tradition with fine modern winemaking practice.

Signos de Origen Syrah 2010 £28

Casablanca Valley, Chile. Intense complexity of flavour: inky, dark fruits and sweet, peppery spice. A serious, organic wine; earthy, full and warming.

FINE WINES – WHITE

Yangarra Estate Roussanne 2009 £42

South Australia. A touch of Aussie class. Vibrant, spicy and refreshing.

Zeltinger Himmelreich Riesling Spätlese, Markus Molitor 2004 £36

Mosel, Germany. Exciting wine: lovely lemon and ripe pear flavours. A vibrant mix of sweetness and acidity, ripeness and minerality.

Jurançon Sec, Domaine Bellegarde 2014 £29

South West France. Racy, citrus scented dry white; delicious acidity, absolutely characteristic of the finest Jurançon. Delightful.

Monte Schiavo Le Giuncare Verdicchio Classico Riserva 2011 £33

Marche, Italy. Iconic late-harvest Verdicchio, part aged in oak. Fresh and sprightly, yet developed and complex with a long finish.

PORT

Wiese & Krohn, Colheita 1998/2001 £43

Portugal. Wonderful single-vintage tawny. The perfect finish.
