Western Cape, South Africa. Ripe and Juicy. Full of dark fruit flavours.

### **Cape Heights Cabernet Sauvignon £18.50**

Western Cape, South Africa. Brambly, bright and succulent.

### **Sierra Grande Merlot £18.50**

Valle Central, Chile. Soft, red fruits; fresh and lively.

France. Fine mousse and fresh, floral aromas. Well-balanced with a fine citrus finish. Great value.

### **Champagne Veuve Cliquot Ponsardin, Yellow Label brut £65.00**

France. Classic, distinctive Champagne – one of the best. Complex, subtle yeast and biscuit flavours. Creamy, lingering dry finish.

**Borsao Garnacha 2019/20 £19.50**

Campo de Borja, Spain. Lively, juicy fruit; subtle hints of spice. Great value.

**Rioja, Vega del Rayo seleccionada 2018/19 £21.80**

Rioja Alta, Spain. Smooth and sophisticated. Generous fruit and good length.

**Sixty Clicks Shiraz/Mataro 2019/21 £21.90**

Central Victoria, Australia. Punchy, delicious all-rounder.

**Novas Gran Reserva Carménère/Cabernet Sauvignon 2015/16 £24.90**

Valle del Colchagua, Chile. Vibrant, powerful organic red. A classic blend.

**Séguret Côtes du Rhône Villages “Les Côteaux Schisteux” 2016/17 £33.50**

Southern Rhône, France. Beautifully constructed with seamless, elegant texture and fantastic length. Definitive Rhône red: subtle, fine and satisfying.

**Barbaresco “Corsini”, Araldica 2014/15 £33.70**

Piedmont, Italy. Vibrant aromas; rich fruit; warm spices and sweet tannins. Classic Italian red from the noble Nebbiolo grape. Just made for beef or lamb.

**Peacock Ridge Merlot 2015/17 £26.80**

Stellenbosch, South Africa. Dark, dense up front fruit balanced by fine, seductive tannins. Long, complex finish.

**Cahors, Château Pinteraie 2016/18 £28.90**

South West France. Top-notch Malbec-based red. Tangy red berry fruit flavours and a delicious long finish of ripe cherries.

**Uggiano Chianti Riserva “Roccialta” 2015/16 £25.50**

Tuscany, Italy. Fresh and appealing style of young Chianti.

**Domaine des Tourelles, 2016/18 £29.50**

Bekaar Valley, Lebanon. Warm and rich with a hint of Arabian spice. From a long-established (founded in 1868) and highly-acclaimed winery.

**Moko Black Pinot Noir 2018/20 £30.50**

New Zealand. Elegant, and pleasingly fresh, with lovely strawberry fruit.

## ROSÉ WINE

**Dunleavy Pinot Noir Rosé 2021 £25.00**

Somerset, England. Lovely English rosé from grapes grown in harmony with nature. Light, vibrant and versatile, with generous fruit flavours.

## WHITE WINES

### **Cave de l'Ormarine VilleMarin Blanc, Côtes de Thau 2020/21 £20.50**

Languedoc, France. Delicate and refreshing with a lively citrus character.

### **Cape Heights Chenin Blanc 2020 £18.50**

Western Cape, South Africa. Fresh and aromatic. Easy and versatile.

### **Tabalí Reserva Viognier 2016/17 £27**

Valle del Limari, Chile. Beautifully aromatic, pure Viognier with mouthfilling, creamy texture. Off-dry and unoaked, soft and rounded. Real value.

### **Kardos Dry Furmint 2017 £27.80**

Tokaj, Hungary. From the historical region of Tokaj, a rich, crisp white with notes of green fruits and an elegant minerality.

### **Casa de Villa Nova Vinho Verde, Villa Nova Alvarinho 2020/21 £21.80**

Minho, Portugal. Bright and citrusy with an appealing softness, displaying the unique characteristics of Vinho Verde. Great with seafood or white meats.

### **Soave Classico, Montresor 2021 £25.50**

Veneto, Italy. Delicate floral aromas and a good depth of ripe, honeyed fruit. A refined example of this renowned and popular wine.

### **Ontañón Vetiver Rioja Blanco 2018/19 £26.50**

Riola Oriental, Spain. 100% Viura: opulent aromas, hints of tropical fruit with well-integrated oak – a classic white Rioja.

### **Moko Black Sauvignon Blanc 2020/21 £28.90**

New Zealand. Definitive Marlborough Sauvignon. Full, layered palate with hints of gooseberry and tropical fruit; clean, with good weight and balance.

### **Turckheim Réserve Riesling 2019 £29.40**

Alsace, France. Elegant, distinguished wine with superb fruit, great acidic balance and an attractive mineral complexity.

## APÉRITIFS/DESSERT WINES

### **Monbazillac, Domaine de Grangeneuve 2013/15 (50cl. bottle) £23**

South West France. Luscious, ethereal and honeyed, with an elegant finish. Great with cheese, or enjoy it French style as an aperitif. Not sticky sweet.

### **Late Harvest Gorka Izagirre Arima 2013/14 (50cl. bottle) £33**

Bizkaiko Txakolina, Spain. Gorgeous Basque sweet wine (sweet but not at all cloying) produced only in exceptional vintages.

## FINE WINES - RED

### **Valenciso Rioja Reserva, Compañía Bodeguera de Valenciso 2010/12 £50**

Rioja Alta, Spain. Pure Tempranillo: rich, elegant and beautifully understated. Combines the best of tradition with fine modern winemaking practice.

### **Caves de Tain Crozes-Hermitage, Nobles Rives 2020 £39**

Northern Rhône, France. Classic structure: supple, fresh and medium-bodied showing floral red fruits with peppery and smoky notes. 100% Syrah.

### **Alasia Barolo 2014/16 £46**

Piedmont, Italy. Expressive style showing richness and structure. Full, firm and ripe.

### **Vacqueyras Grand Montmirail, Yves Cheron 2020 £50**

Southern Rhône, France. Well structured Grenache based blend. A deep and sensuous red with plenty of dark, brambly fruit and supple tannins.

### **Bandol, Domaine Bunan 2019 £55**

Provence, France. From a region with a long history of viticulture, reds such as this fine example exhibit intense, mouth-filling flavours, pairing well with rich dishes.

### **Amarone della Valpolicella "Satinato" 2017 (37.5cl. bottle) £32**

Veneto, Italy. Delicious Amarone in a modern style – rich and warming yet fresh and well-balanced. Ripe, sweet fruit with notes of chocolate and bitter cherry.

## FINE WINES – WHITE

### **Valenciso Rioja Blanco, Compañía Bodeguerra de Valenciso 2020 £50**

Rioja Alta, Spain. Fermented in oak for nine months, this fine Rioja displays complex aromas with lemon and smoky notes. The intense and broad palate balances attractive minerality with gentle citric acidity.

### **Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine Bouchié-Chevalier "Pierre à Fusil" 2020 £47**

Loire, France. Delightful example of French Sauvignon Blanc; elegant and refined.

### **Gewüztraminer, Cave de Turckheim Grand Cru Brand 2016 £43**

Alsace, France. Aromatic, with notes of exotic fruit and floral aromas. Ripe, rich and complex fruit. Finely structured with good balance.

### **Jurançon Sec "Energique", Domaine Bellegarde 2019 £48**

South west France. Racy, citrus scented dry white; delicious acidity, absolutely characteristic of the finest Jurançon. Delightful.

## PORT

### **Wiese & Krohn, Colheita 2002/2007 £38**

Portugal. Wonderful single-vintage tawny. The perfect finish.
