

# GIN

## **Adnam's Copper House 40%**

From famed Southwold brewer Adnams. Drawing on their brewing experience they've made a barley spirit and used it as a base for a big juniper heavy gin.

## **Adnam's First Rate 48%**

Distilled from locally-grown barley, wheat and oats. Adnams makes a beer 'wash' from these grains which is fermented to around 6% abv without hops. This is then reduced to a pure spirit. Only the very purest portion of the spirit is drawn off, the finest cut, which is returned to the copper pot still to be redistilled and infused with thirteen carefully chosen botanicals.

## **Adnam's Rising Sun 42%**

Made from malted rye, this gin has been produced using the London Dry method with added Japanese Matcha Tea, lemongrass and juniper berries plus a specially selected blend of botanicals (orange peel, ginger, grains of paradise, cubeb, angelica). This Gin is refreshing and full of natural aromatic flavours, best served with a good tonic.

## **Aviation American Gin 42%**

Batch distilled Gin from Oregon, Dutch in style, distilled from rye and flavoured with juniper, lavender, anise, sarsaparilla, orange peel and cardamom.

## **Bathtub Gin 43.3%**

**NEW!** An extraordinary award-winning gin from Ableforth's. Made using the traditional method of Cold Compounding (or in layman's terms – infusing). Very high-quality copper pot-still spirit is infused with ingredients including juniper, orange peel, coriander, cassia, cloves and cardamom, with the length of the compounding period controlled entirely by periodic sampling.

## **Berry Bros. No.3 Gin 46%**

Made to a special recipe, the name No.3 refers to the address of BBR - Number 3, St James's Street. With juniper at its heart, it's also made with three fruits and three spices using copper pot stills.

## **Blackwood's Vintage Dry Gin 40%**

Made with hand-harvested Shetland botanicals picked fresh each summer by local crofters, this gin is always fresh and lively but uniquely reflects each vintage. At time of going to print the vintage was 2012.

## **Bloom London Dry Gin 40%**

In 2010 it was awarded a Platinum Medal at the World Spirits Competition. The name references the aromatic qualities of the botanicals within which include honeysuckle, pomelo and chamomile.

## **Bombay London Dry Gin 37.5%**

One of the great old-school style London Gins, Bombay Original was first introduced in 1959 and is the precursor of the now more famous Bombay Sapphire.

## **Bombay Sapphire Gin 40%**

Credited with kick-starting gin's fashionability since its launch in 1987, Bombay Sapphire has become a truly iconic brand, with its distinctive blue bottle recognisable in bars the world over.

## **The Botanist Islay Dry Gin 46%**

An unusual gin from Islay whisky distillery Bruichladdich, made in a Lomond still christened Ugly Betty. It contains 31 botanicals, of which 22 are native to Islay itself. These include the likes of mugwort, meadowsweet and Lady's Bedstraw flowers. The resultant dry gin is described, unsurprisingly, as 'floral'.

## **Brecon Botanicals 43%**

A small batch premium gin from Wales's Penderyn distillery. Originally produced for the gin-mad Spanish market, this is diluted to a punchier-than-usual 43% with Brecon Beacons water.

## **Brockman's 40%**

Flavoured with 10 botanicals, Brockmans is proud of its 'Intensely Smooth' and fruity gin, one that's equally at home with tonic or ginger ale, as well as just on its own over ice.

## **Brooklyn 40%**

Multi award winning - Brooklyn Gin is full of flavour with freshness and complexity. Using 100% fresh citrus peels and hand cracked juniper, which releases the essential oils, results in this renowned American gin.

## **Bulldog 40%**

A delicious English gin made with poppy, dragon eye, lotus leaves, citrus, almond, lavender and various other botanicals. This is four times distilled in copper pot stills, and Bulldog had the highest rating ever received by a gin from Wine Enthusiast Magazine.

## **Burleigh's London Dry Gin 40%**

**NEW!** Inspired by a walk in Burleigh Wood, where master distiller Jamie Baxter happened to come across silver birch, dandelion, burdock, elderberry and iris. From this, delicious ideas bloomed and the end result is an earthy, crisp, sophisticated gin from Leicestershire. There are 11 botanicals in the citrus-forward Burleighs Signature London Dry Gin, including those inspired by that walk in the woods.

## **Caorunn Small Batch gin 41.8%**

Scottish gin from the Balmenach distillery in Speyside. Caorunn (pronounced ka-roon), made with a combination of traditional and handpicked botanicals including rowan berry, heather, coul blush apple and dandelion.

## **Cheshire Grins Gin 40%**

**NEW!** A tasty gin with very local roots. Cheshire Grins Gin is made with a selection of botanicals including Cheshire blueberries (as well as lemon, orange, cucumber, orris, nutmeg, cinnamon and juniper), giving it a fruity kick of sweetness. They use Peckforton spring water from the mid-Cheshire ridge. All presented in a giant aftershave bottle!

## **Cotswolds Dry Gin 46%**

A classic well-balanced juniper-led gin with crisp citrus and spice. This gin is delicious on its own and over ice. It's robust enough to stand up to tonic and smooth enough to craft the ultimate gin martini.

## **Cuckoo Gin 43%**

**NEW!** A classically juniper-forward gin from the Lancashire-based Brindle Distillery, produced with a big focus on sustainability and general eco-friendly goodness. They will locally source or simply grow the raw materials used in the gin, sustainable and ethically source botanicals from around the world and heat their still (dubbed Maggie) with renewable energy biomass boilers. Any waste or by-products are put to good use on the farm either as cattle food, chicken bedding or compost

## **Cucumber Gin 40%**

**NEW!** Clear, clean and subtly sweet. Balanced by oily, peppery juniper and touches of mint. A refreshing tipple from the English Drinks Company of Shrewsbury.

## **Daffy's Gin 43.4%**

**NEW!** Made with grain spirit from northern France, which is then distilled using a copper pot still. The Scottish distillers use a selection of eight botanicals for Daffy's Gin, including juniper, Lebanese mint, coriander, angelica root, Spanish lemon and orange peels, cassia bark and orris root.

## **Dà Mhìle Organic Seaweed Gin 42%**

With a mix of 20 organic botanicals, from the old favourites juniper and coriander to some interesting and home-grown treats like red and white clover, gorse and chamomile, the Welsh Dà Mhìle distillery have created a unique, small batch gin.

## **Death's Door Gin 47%**

Wisconsin. Made in small batches with organic red winter wheat on Washington Island and bottled at a higher-than-usual strength.

## **Dictador Premium Columbian Aged Gin - Ortodoxo 43%**

**NEW!** Inspired by English gin, but made from a unique blend of Columbian berries, botanicals, peels, roots and spices. It is rested for a time in Dictador rum barrels to allow the flavours to intensify. There is fruit and spice from blueberry, ginger and cinnamon and the smooth finish of a classic gin. Enjoy with ice and tonic water.

## **Edinburgh Seaside Gin 43%**

A limited edition making use of some intriguing Scottish ingredients from the coast, like seaweed, ground ivy, gorse flowers and scurvy grass (which sailors used to eat when suffering from scurvy for its precious Vitamin C). A superb summer tipple capturing the essence of the seaside.

## **Forest Gin 42%**

Cheshire. Hand-crafted, small-batch gin produced using a range of botanicals native to Macclesfield Forest, such as wild bilberries, wild gorse flowers, wild raspberries, and local moss. Most is sold at Harvey Nichols. Organic.

## **Gabriel Boudier Saffron Gin 40%**

Made to a unique recipe discovered in the annals of French Colonial past when both England and France claimed India as it was rich in exotic botanicals. The gin is handcrafted in small batches

## **Gin Mare 42.7%**

Gin Mare (meaning 'sea') is inspired by Mediterranean culture and made using the finest botanicals of the region, such as Arbequina olives, thyme, rosemary and basil.

## **Ginsmiths of Liverpool Marshmallow Gin 40%**

**NEW!** This gin is made by hand in the heart of Liverpool. Unique and wonderfully decadent, The Ginsmiths have combined the dryness of their dry gin with the sweetness of marshmallow root. The resulting gin is dry with a lovely sweet aftertaste, perfect for those that like the sweetness and flavour of Marshmallow!

## **Gordon's London Dry Gin 37.5%**

One of the top ten-selling spirits in the world, and has been made to the same recipe since the late 18th Century. Although not the same ABV.

## **Hayman's Family Reserve 41.3%**

London. Rested in Scotch whisky casks for three weeks before bottling. This imparts fragrant notes of oak and a softer mouth feel to the gin.

## **Hayman's London Dry 40%**

Juniper, coriander, orange and lemon peel are used to craft this distinctive gin, loads of flavour, loads of body. A first class London Dry.

## **Hayman's Old Tom 40%**

An old-fashioned, sweeter style gin recipe from the 18th Century. Recently this style has risen in popularity thanks to its association with classic gin cocktails.

### **Hayman's Royal Dock Navy Strength 57%**

Created following demand for higher strength spirits from bartenders and is named after the old Naval base in Deptford, East London.

### **Hendrick's Gin 41.4%, £3.60**

A superb, and utterly unique, pink-tinged gin from William Grant's. Infused with rose petals and cucumber as well as the normal botanicals, this is a must for all gin-lovers.

### **Hunter's Cheshire Gin 43.3%**

A wonderful premium gin from Cheshire. It's made in traditional copper pot and rectifying stills (some of which being more than a century old!) and is flavoured with botanicals including juniper from the Balkans, French angelica, Spanish lemon peel and Florentine orris root.

### **King of Soho Gin 42%**

The King of Soho London Dry Gin is distilled in London. The brainchild of Howard Raymond as a tribute to his late father - 'The King of Soho', Paul Raymond. 12 botanicals are used in the production, including coriander, grapefruit peel, angelica root and cassia.

### **Langley's No.8 London Gin 41.7%**

Named after the number of botanicals used. Aimed at the sophisticated male gin drinker. Made in small batches using the purest 100% English Grain Spirit, it is hand crafted specifically to let the selected botanicals do the talking. An old-fashioned gin, perfect for a traditional gin and tonic.

### **Leopold's Gin 40%**

Made from grain and botanicals which are organic within the city's boundaries. The botanicals include coriander, angelica and citrus.

### **Liverpool Gin 47%**

Finest coriander, angelica and citrus, plus hand-picked juniper berries result in a gin with a well balanced nose, complex flavours and a long finish.

### **The London No.1 Original Blue Gin 47%**

Beautiful quadruple-distilled gin made by Charles Maxwell in London. It is flavoured with botanicals including cinnamon, angelica, bergamot and gardenia and has a slight blue tint.

### **Lone Wolf 44%**

**NEW!** Brewdog's mission to take beer to another level are matched by their desire to become a force in the gin market. LoneWolf Gin is made with their own malted barley spirit, and features a selection of botanicals including juniper, Thai lemongrass, Kaffir lime leaf, angelica, coriander, cardamom, pink peppercorn, almond, lavender, fresh lemon and red grapefruit peels, mace and Scots pine needles.

### **Martin Miller's England Iceland 40%**

Small batch pot still gin, blended with extra-pure Icelandic spring water. Martin Miller's gin is rated 94 points (Exceptional) by the Beverage Testing Institute.

### **Mombasa Club London Dry 41.5%**

**NEW!** Takes its name from a private social club founded in 1885, whom imported gin from England to the island of Zanzibar for their members to enjoy. It is four times distilled and features a botanical selection that includes juniper, cassia bark, angelica root, coriander seed, clove and cumin, resulting in a bold, spicy flavour profile.

### **Monkey 47 Schwarzwald Dry Gin 47%**

**NEW!** From Germany's Black Forest. An exotic gin made with a molasses base. The 47 refers to the number of botanicals used which includes such unlikely fruit ingredients like lingonberries, blackberries, and honey pomelo. These are combined with a host of recognizable gin botanicals such as chamomile, sage, angelica, coriander, and a whole array of others. Another anomaly at Monkey 47 is that the distillate is aged in earthenware containers for three months before being brought to 47 degrees alcohol with the forest's celebrated water.

### **Nelson's London Dry Gin 42%**

**NEW!** A small batch gin from Nelson's Distillery & Gin School in Grindley near the Uttoxeter. Made with a range of botanicals from around the globe including lemongrass and kaffir lime leaves from Thailand, vanilla from Madagascar and cinnamon from Sri Lanka.

### **Opihr Oriental Spiced 40%**

A premium spiced gin. Along with some of the regular botanicals you'd expect in a London Dry they also infused cubeb from Indonesia, black pepper from India and Moroccan Coriander for a uniquely spicy flavour.

### **Plymouth Gin 41.2%**

Made at the historic Black Friars Distillery in the Devon town, it is drier than the London Dry style. Much respected and geographically protected.

### **Polo Gin 37.5%**

**NEW!** Founded in 2016 by polo playing father and son Nick and Richard Hine. It is proudly British and quadruple distilled using only organic ingredients to create the most flavoursome and smooth of gins. It is handmade in small batches in a wood fuelled still using Ceredigion's finest, pure spring water.

### **Revolution Gin 42%**

**NEW!** A grain to glass gin from Telford's Ironbridge Spirit Co. made with Wenlock Spring water and complete with industrial revolution-themed label to celebrate the area's history.

### **Scapegrace Dry Gin 42.2%**

Distilled in New Zealand using spring water sourced from the country's Southern Alps, and 12 botanicals sourced from around the world, the spirit is batch-distilled using a restored 19th century copper whisky still.

### **Silent Pool Gin 37.5%**

From a small distillery in the Surrey hills. A rich and clean, juniper driven spirit with floral layers of lavender and chamomile, notes of citrus and kaffir lime, grounded with the subtle sweetness of local honey.

### **Sipsmith London Dry Gin 41.6%**

Distilled from the finest English wheat spirit with ten carefully selected botanicals, and blended with the exceptionally pure water of Lydwell spring, the source of the River Thames.

### **Sipsmith V.J.O.P. Gin 57.7%**

Very Junipery Over Proof. Sipsmith employ a 'triple juniper' technique which adds the juniper at three stages - first it is macerated for three days, then more juniper is added to the pot still and finally vapour infused into the spirit.

### **Sir Robin of Locksley Gin 40.5%**

Sheffield. Has a radiant flavour profile thanks to the botanical selection, which includes elderflower, dandelion and pink grapefruit. Delicious on its own.

### **Skully Smooth Wasabi Gin 41.8%**

**NEW!** Wasabi root, sweet orange, ginger and mint combine with Skully London Dry Gin for no reason other than Skully wanted them to. Distilled 100% grain at 41.8% ABV. Powerful aroma and silky-smooth taste.

### **Slingsby London Dry Gin 42%**

**NEW!** Slingsby is a London Dry Gin that's proudly from the Yorkshire town of Harrogate. Launched in August 2015, it's made with water from the Harrogate aquifer, pure grain spirit and 24 botanicals and comes in a smart, locally produced blue bottle.

### **Sloane's Dry Gin 40%**

**NEW!** Made in the Netherlands. A hearty handful of botanicals have gone into Sloane's gin, including iris root, coriander, angelica root, cardamom pods, liquorice root and whole vanilla beans. Sloane's individually distill each of these botanicals for their gin, resulting in a unique flavour profile that seduces the palate.

### **Star of Bombay 47.5%**

A higher-strength, premium variant of Bombay Sapphire. The classic notes of juniper, angelica and coriander have been intensified, with the addition of bergamot and ambrette seeds offering extra ex5oticness. A rich and intense gin.

### **Steam Punk Gin 40%**

**NEW!** Taking inspiration from the top-hatted world of Steam Punk, Steam Punk Gin is made with seven "peculiar" botanicals from around the world, as well as the much less peculiar juniper berry.

### **Tanqueray London Dry Gin 43.1%**

Very popular gin. Has a fruity, spicy palate with big zesty, citrusy top notes which make this gin the perfect all-rounder.

### **Tanqueray Rangpur 41.3%**

Flavoured with Rangpur limes (also known as mandarin oranges). These highly acidic fruits, actually orange in colour, impart a fresh, zesty zing to this refreshing gin.

### **Tanqueray No. 10 47.3%**

A fine small batch London dry gin made in pot still number 10. It is citrusy and full bodied.

### **Thomas Dakin Manchester Gin 42%**

Made with eleven botanicals including juniper, orange peel, English coriander, angelica, cubeb pepper and liquorice as well as "a hint of red cole" aka horseradish! It's named after Thomas Dakin, who began producing gin in Warrington in the second half of the 18th century, founding what would later become Greenall's.

### **Tiger Gin 40%**

**NEW!** A premium quality gin distilled in Shrewsbury using pure English water blended with the finest quality botanicals, spices and grain that is carefully selected and sourced each season from the best harvests around the world. Tiger Gin is crafted by artisan master distillers using traditional methods.

### **Turncoat London Dry Gin 40%**

**NEW!** A handcrafted confident London Dry Gin. A very forward and long lasting Juniper flavour with a spicy dry or nutty finish brought along by 11 botanicals including U.S Black Walnut Leaf. Works very well as a sipping gin, or in a Pink Gin.

### **Turncoat Cascade Gin 43%**

**NEW!** This unique gin incorporates Cascade Hops in its flavour profile. Cascade is the founding father of the Craft Beer Revolution.

### **Warner Edwards Harrington Dry 44%**

Northamptonshire. Produced in a barn in the village of Harrington. The main three botanicals are juniper, coriander and cardamom, which have helped to produce a gin that's beautifully balanced.

### **William's Chase Great British Extra Dry 40%**

A lighter but more powerfully flavoured gin from the folks at Williams Chase – an extra dry.

### **William's Chase Elegant Gin 48%**

A deliciously tasty gin from Herefordshire. Wonderfully fresh (and pleasantly potent) gin, distilled from their own organically grown apples.

## FRUITY GINS

### **Burleigh's London Dry Pink Edition 40%**

**NEW!** A limited edition bottling of Burleigh's London Dry Gin, inspired by the Master Distiller's trip to Japan. Burleigh's Gin Pink Edition has been distilled using their classic recipe with the addition of Japanese cherry blossom, pink grapefruit, hibiscus and rose flowers.

### **Eden Mill Love Gin 42%**

**NEW!** Eden Mill, a well-regarded Scottish craft beer producer, have embraced distilling and are clearly having great fun. This Love Gin is made with juniper, coriander seed and angelica as well as rhubarb root, rose petal, goji berry, elderberry, marshmallow root and raspberry leaf! It's then infused with hibiscus flowers post distillation. Try with Fever Tree tonic.

### **Foxdenton Sloe Gin 27%**

The traditional flask filler made from the fruit of the Blackthorn. Drier and stronger than most of the alternatives. Rich and warming on its own or it makes a great alternative to cassis with champagne. See the Goliath bottle on the bar.

### **Ginsmiths of Liverpool Marshmallow Gin 27%**

The traditional flask filler made from the fruit of the Blackthorn. Drier and stronger than most of the alternatives. Rich and warming on its own or it makes a great alternative to cassis with champagne.

### **Hayman's Sloe Gin 26%**

A rich ruby red liqueur bursting with smooth and intense bitter sweet fruit flavours. Made to a long standing family recipe with wild, hand-picked sloe berries.

### **Pinkster 37.5%**

The 'Agreeably British Gin', 5 botanicals are used to create this gin. Pinkster is the brainchild of Stephen Marsh, and is now distilled to the company's own recipe by G&J before being hand-steeped in the raspberries that lend it both its pink hue and subtle fruitiness.

### **Puerto de Indias Strawberry Gin 37.5%,**

Combining notes of juniper and strawberry, this is a vibrantly fruit-forward Spanish gin - evidently made by accident after trying to create a strawberry liqueur! Very light and sweet, this should make for a fine summer tippie.

### **Manchester Gin Raspberry Infused 40%**

**NEW!** A limited edition variation on the standard Manchester Gin recipe featuring an infusion of raspberries. Excellent for cocktails and mixed drinks - and ought to be delicious splashed in a glass of sparkling wine.

### **Sipsmith Sloe Gin 29%**

A blend of Sipsmith London Dry Gin and hand-picked Dartmoor sloe berries. Subtle, complex and bursting with flavour.

### **Slingsby Rhubarb Gin 40%**

**NEW!** A limited edition rhubarb flavoured gin from Yorkshire made with locally sourced botanicals and Harrogate aquifer water. Tart rhubarb, subtle summer berries, citrus, juniper and gentle spice. Great with tonic and a slice of pink grapefruit.

### **Warner Edwards Honeybee Gin 43%**

**NEW!** Built around an infusion of locally-sourced honey, including honey from their very own hives on their farm! Other botanicals include a trio of citrus peels (grapefruit, orange and lemon), elderflower, hibiscus, cinnamon and cardamom, among others.

### **Warner Edwards Victoria's Rhubarb Gin 40%**

Made with Queen Victoria rhubarb, a type formerly grown at Buckingham Palace. Softened, pressed, and combined with Harrington Dry Gin. Works exceptionally well with tonic or ginger ale.

### **Warner Edwards Sloe Gin 30%**

Combines their Dry Gin - with the main three botanicals of juniper, coriander and cardamom - and handpicked sloes from England and Wales.

### **Warner Edwards Elderflower Gin 40%**

Uses Harrington Dry as a base, which is then infused with fresh elderflower from Harrington in Northamptonshire and Rhuallt in North Wales.

### **Whitley Neill Blood Orange Gin 43%,**

**NEW!** a refreshing, intense orange aroma, hints of liquorice and coriander, and a smooth finish.

### **Whitley Neill Rhubarb & Ginger Gin 43%**

**NEW!** Infused with the essence of rhubarb and extracts of real ginger giving it both a tart crispness and spicy, warming character. Sweet, fruity and moreish. Try with Fever-Tree Mediterranean tonic and garnished with orange, or ginger ale and lemon.

### **Whitley Neill Raspberry Gin 43%**

**NEW!** Invigorating tartness from Scottish raspberries is complemented perfectly by undertones of liquorice and coriander leading to a well-rounded finish.

### **Williams Chase Seville Orange Gin 40%**

The Elegant Gin, re-distilled and marinated through fresh Seville Orange marmalade. Light nectar in appearance, natural floral oils upfront followed by fruity notes like a luscious hot cross bun.

**Williams Chase Pink Grapefruit Gin 40%**

**NEW!** Perfect for a G&T on a hot summer afternoon, this is bursting at the seams with exciting grapefruit notes, with a handful of peppery juniper notes at its core.
